Question: Out of the 5,801 IDD caregiving families, what is the percentage of family caregivers of people with IDD aged 60 or older in 2019?



5,801 IDD caregiving families



= Family caregivers for people with IDD aged 60 and over

Answer: Out of the 5,801 IDD caregiving families, 24% of, or roughly 1,392 family caregivers were for people with IDD aged 60 or older.
