Question: Out of the **5,801 IDD caregiving families**, what is the **percentage of family caregivers of people with IDD aged 60 or older in 2019?**



  = 1,000 families

  = Family caregivers for people with IDD aged 60 and over

Answer: Out of the **5,801 IDD caregiving families**, **24% of, or roughly 1,392 family caregivers** were for **people with IDD aged 60 or older.**

Definitions

IDD caregiving families: Families who provide care to 1 or more family members with IDD, usually an adult family member.
