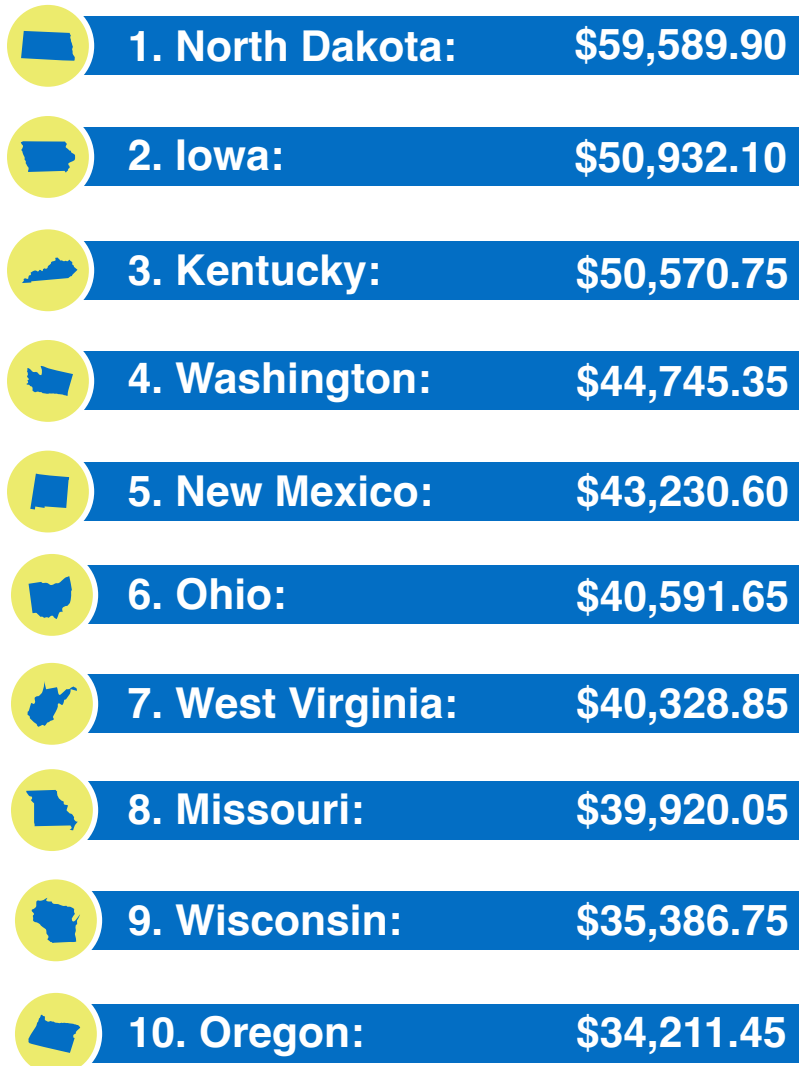


# Data Bites 8.0 August 2023

## Definitions

**HCBS:** HCBS provides opportunities for Medicaid beneficiaries to receive services in their own home or community rather than in institutions or other isolated settings.
