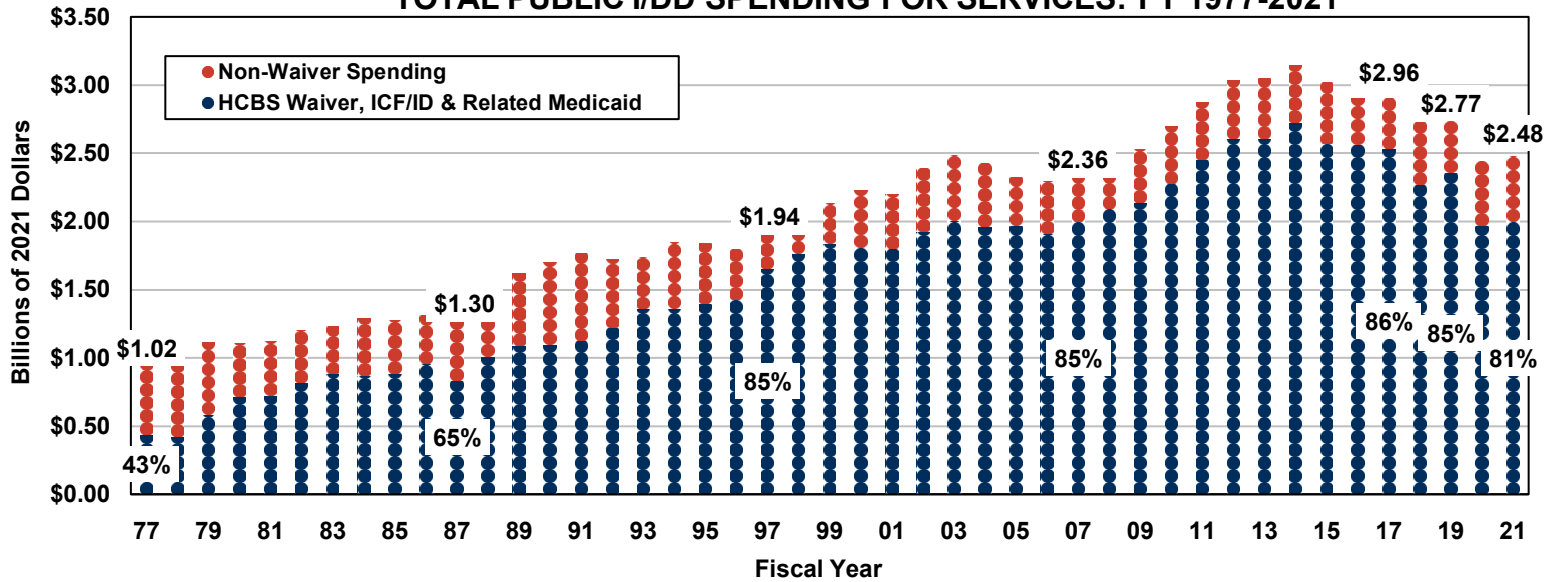
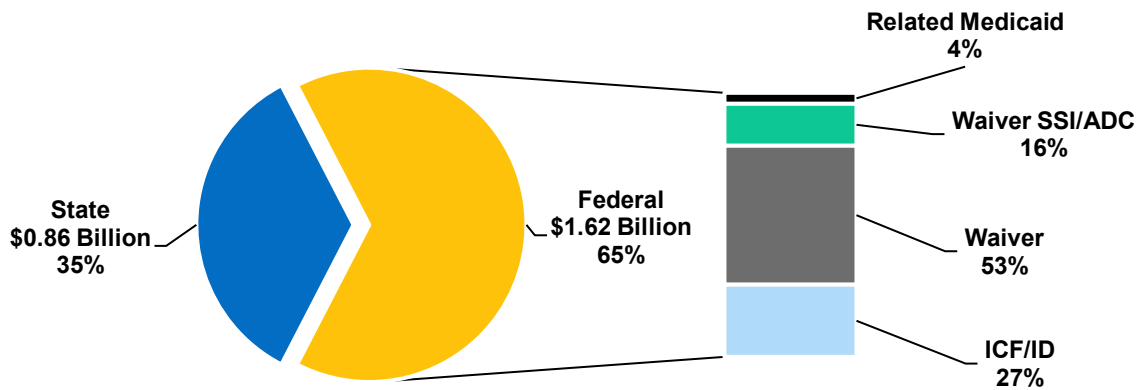


**TOTAL PUBLIC I/DD SPENDING FOR SERVICES: FY 1977-2021**

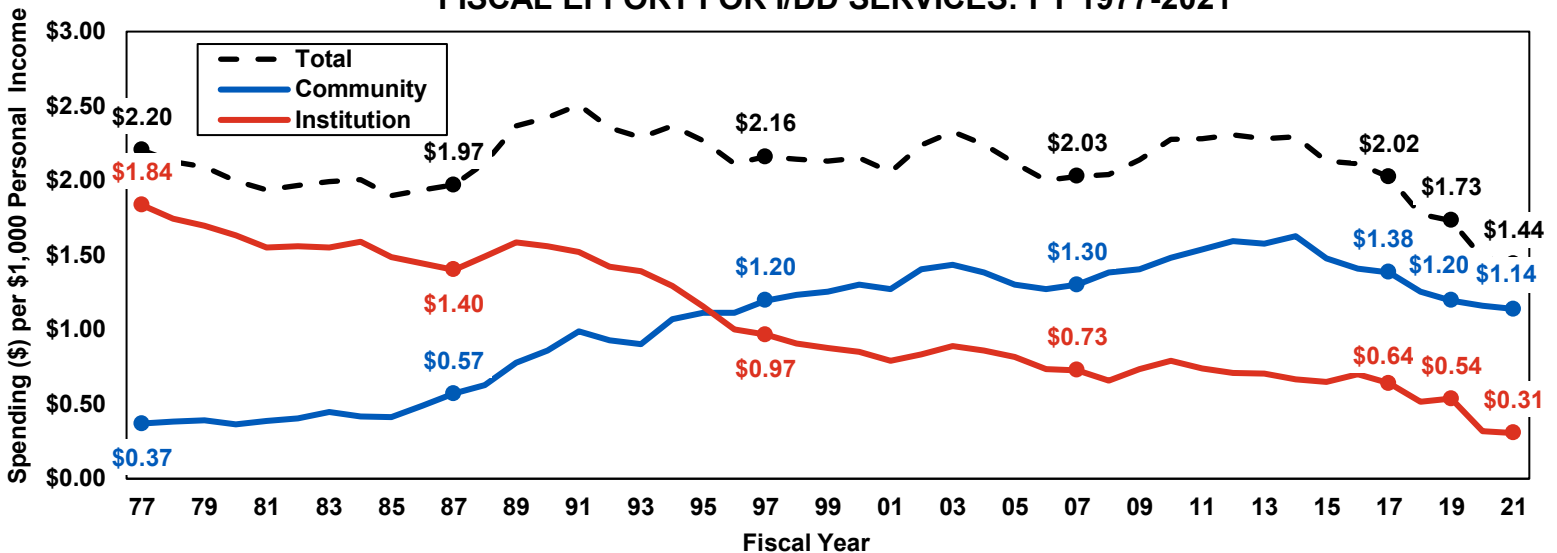


**PUBLIC I/DD SPENDING BY REVENUE SOURCE: FY 2021**

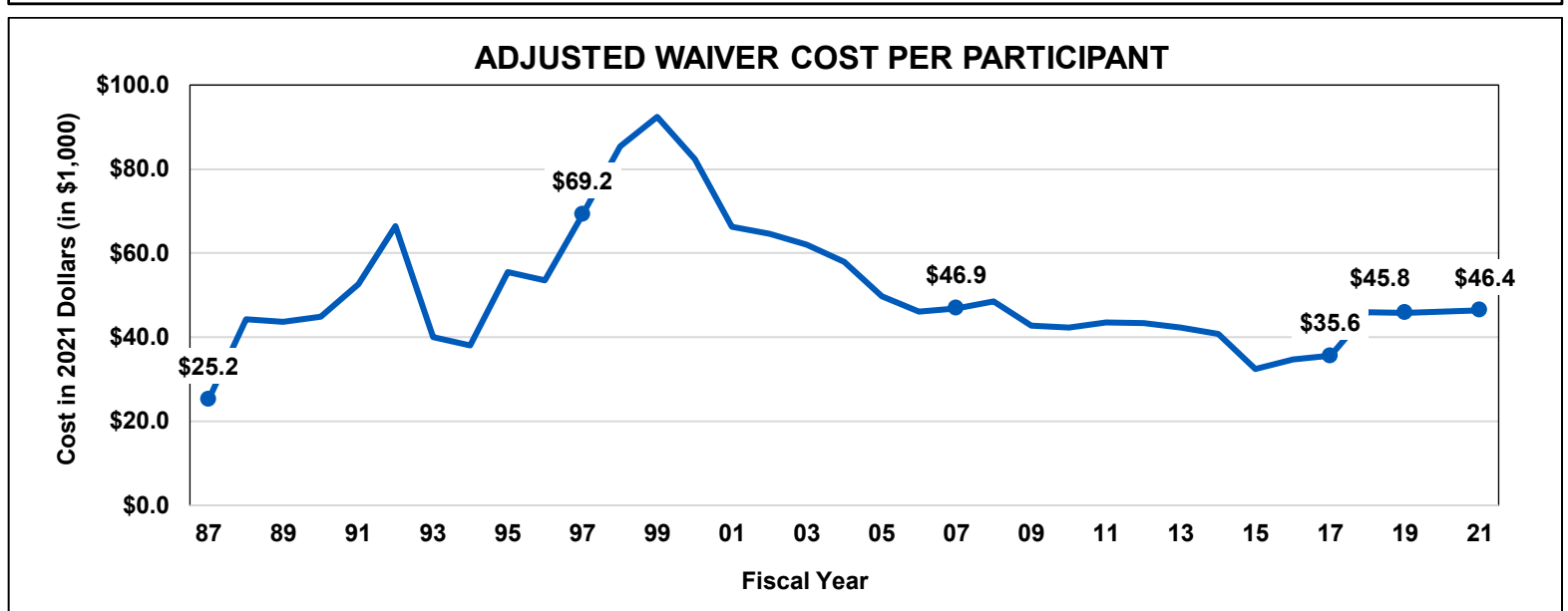
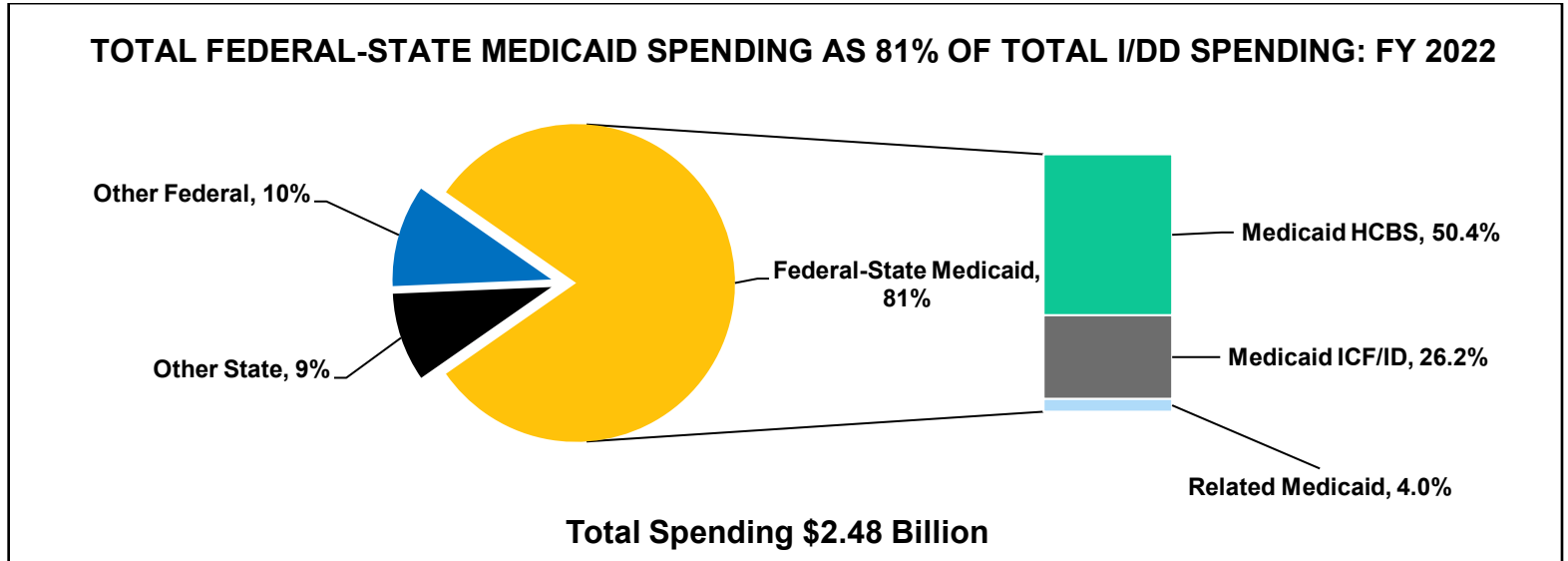
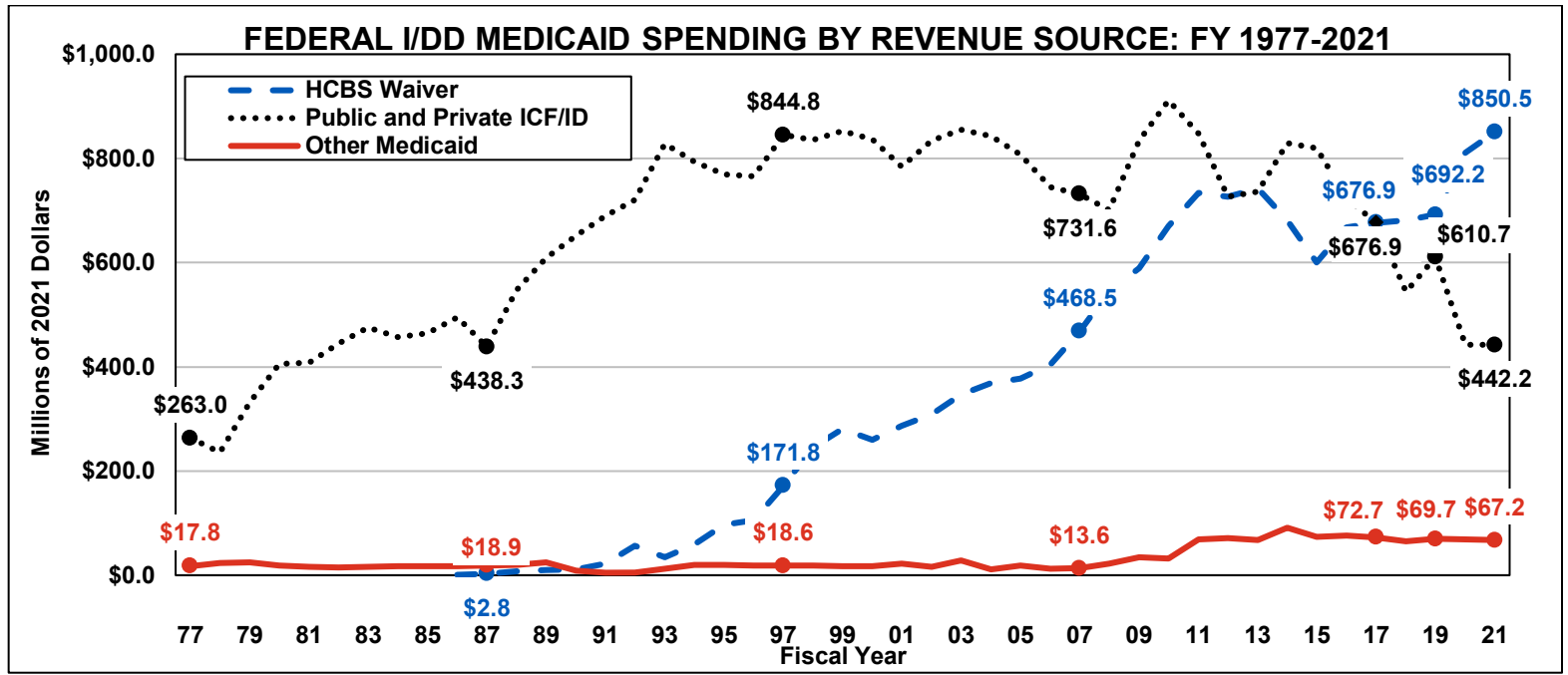

**FISCAL EFFORT FOR I/DD SERVICES: FY 1977-2021**



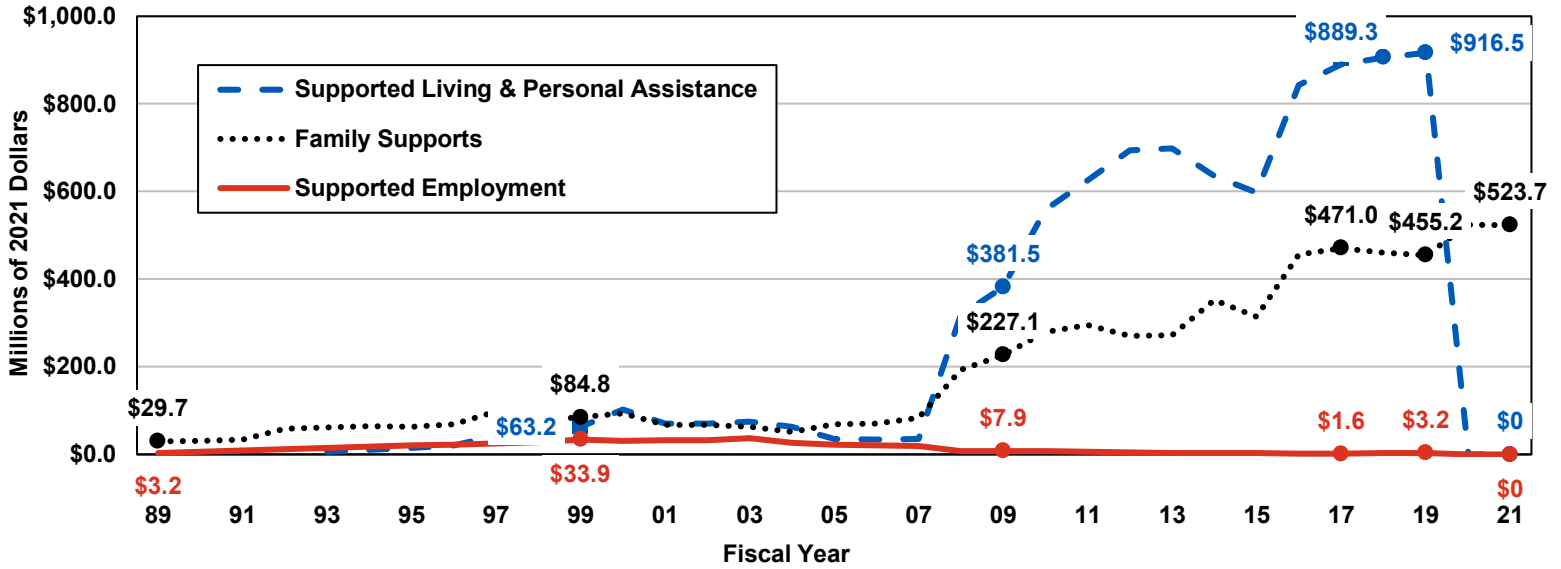

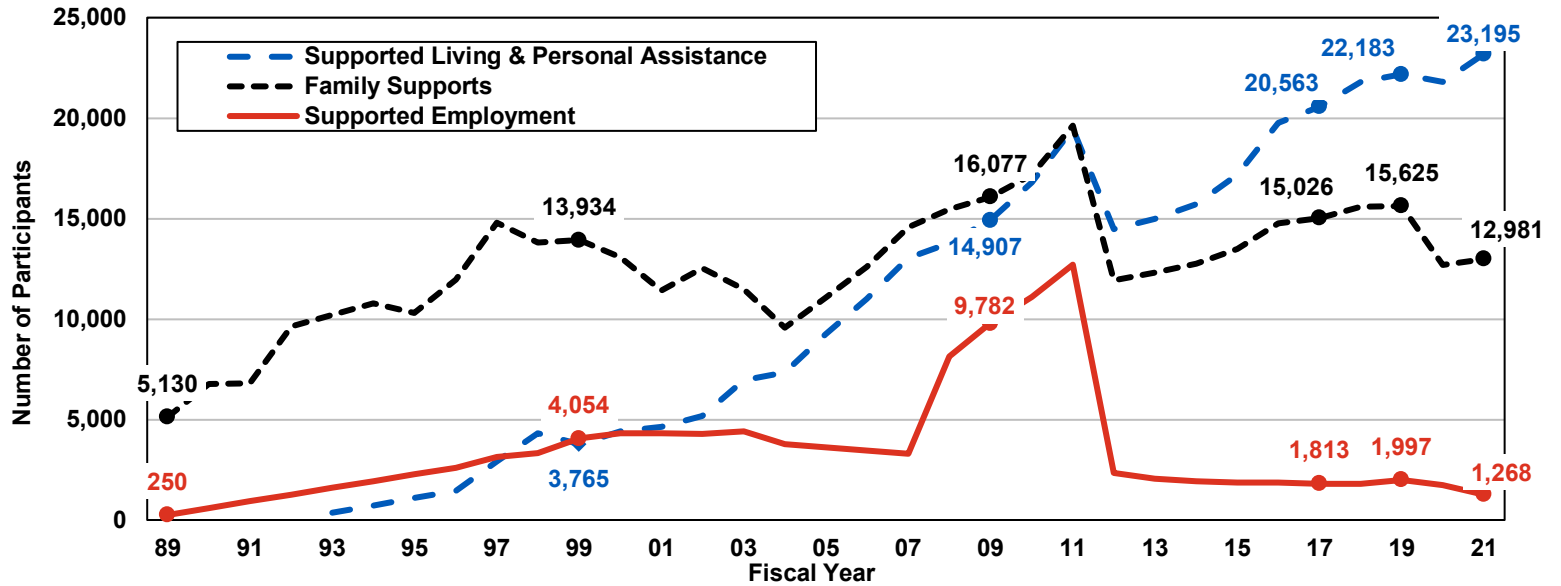

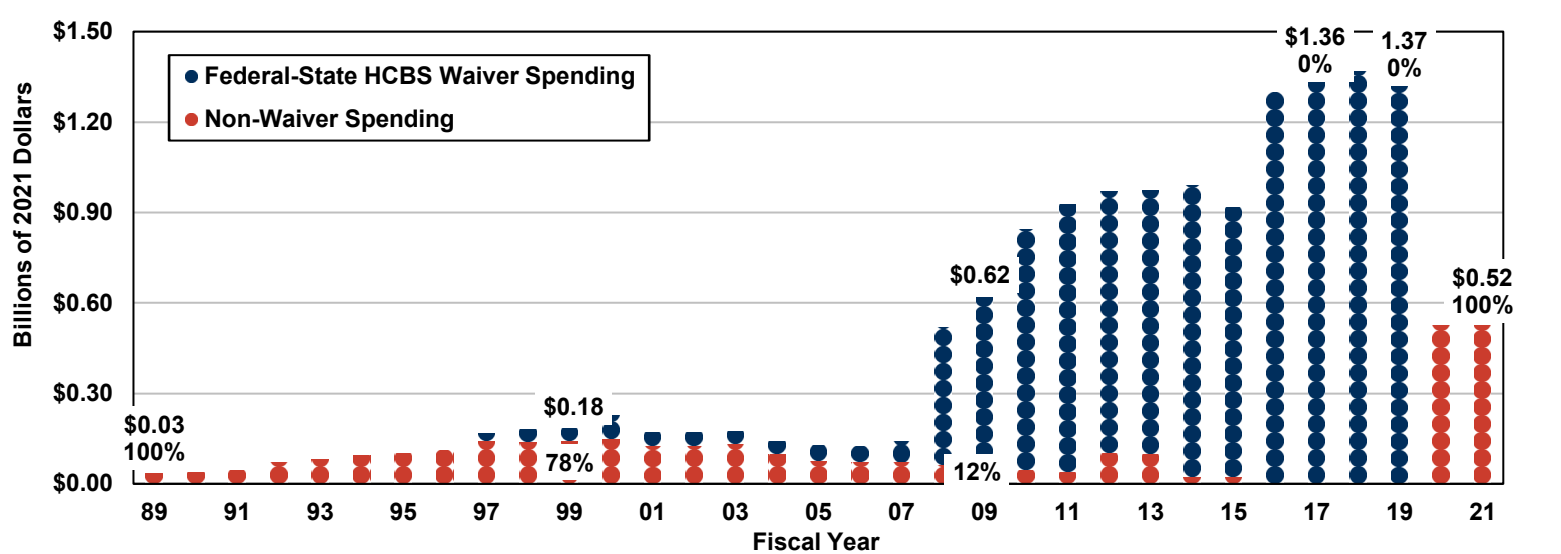
INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY SUPPORT SPENDING: FY 1989-2021



INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY SUPPORT PARTICIPANTS: FY 1989-2021

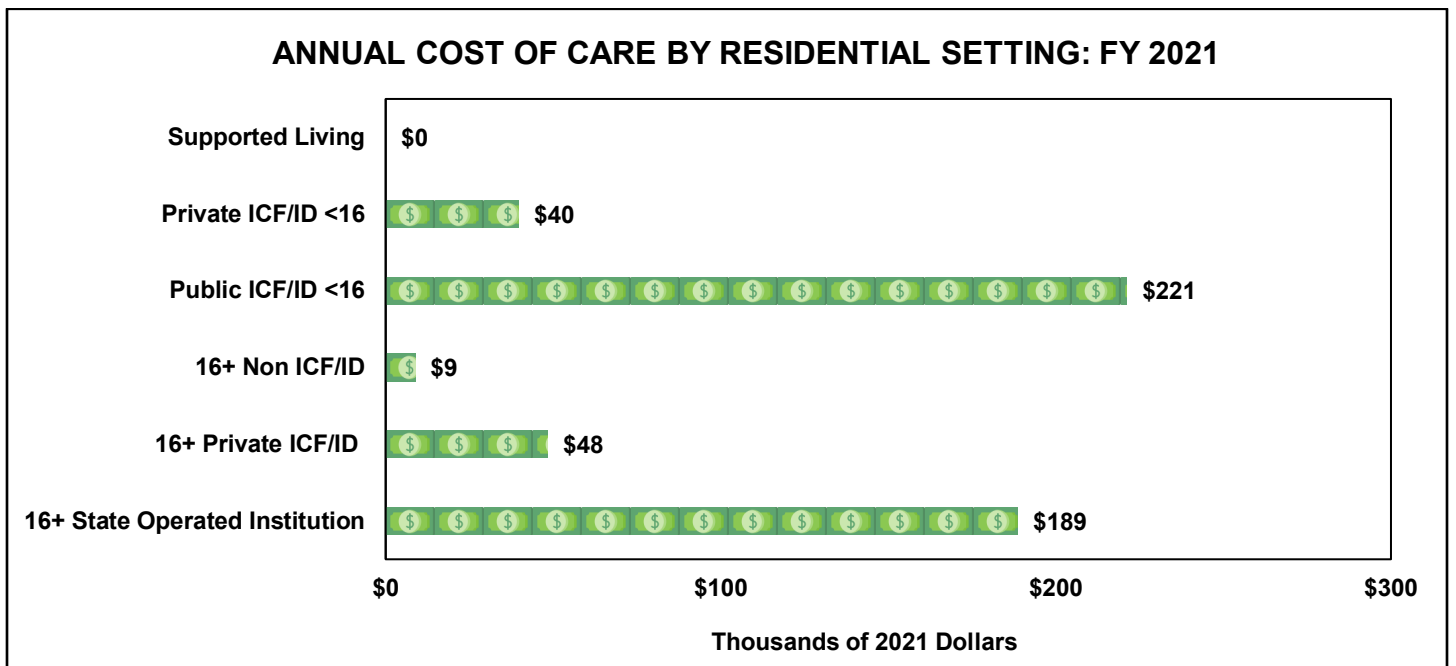


INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY SUPPORT SPENDING BY REVENUE SOURCE: FY 1989-2021

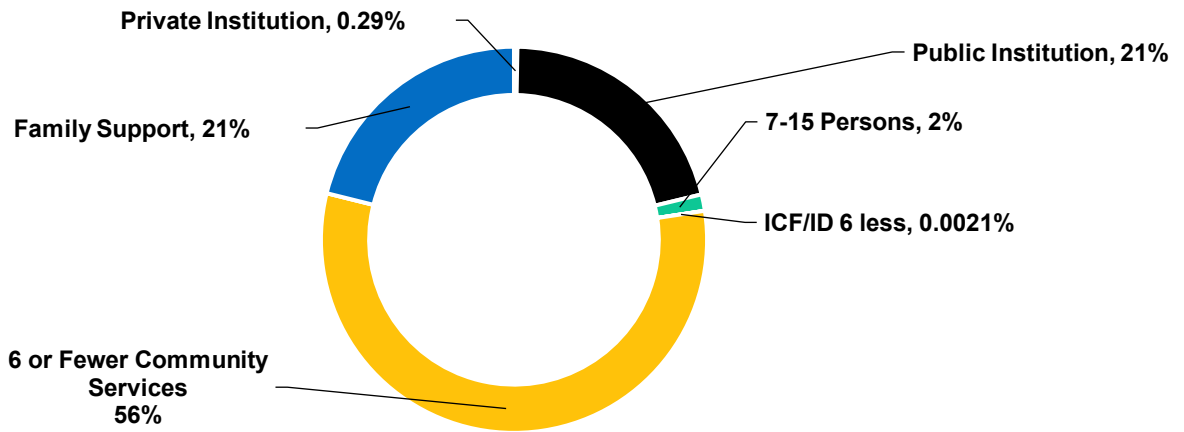

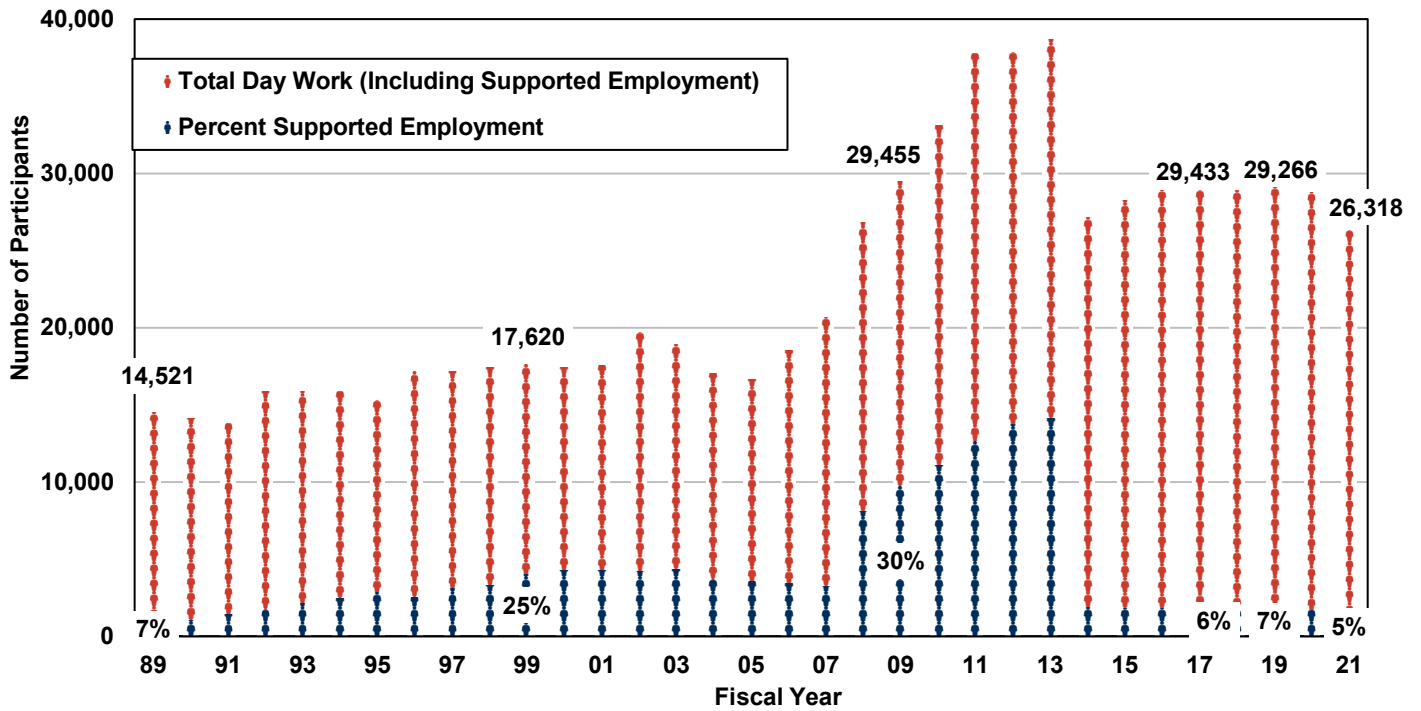

**I/DD EXPENDITURES AS A PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL SPENDING BY CATEGORY: FY 2021**



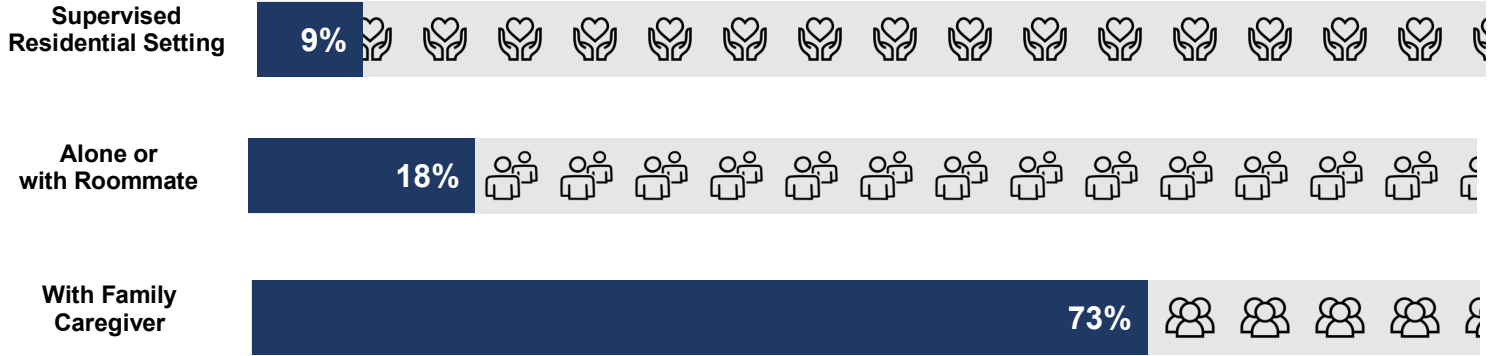

**TOTAL DAY WORK AND SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT PARTICIPANTS: FY 1989-2021**

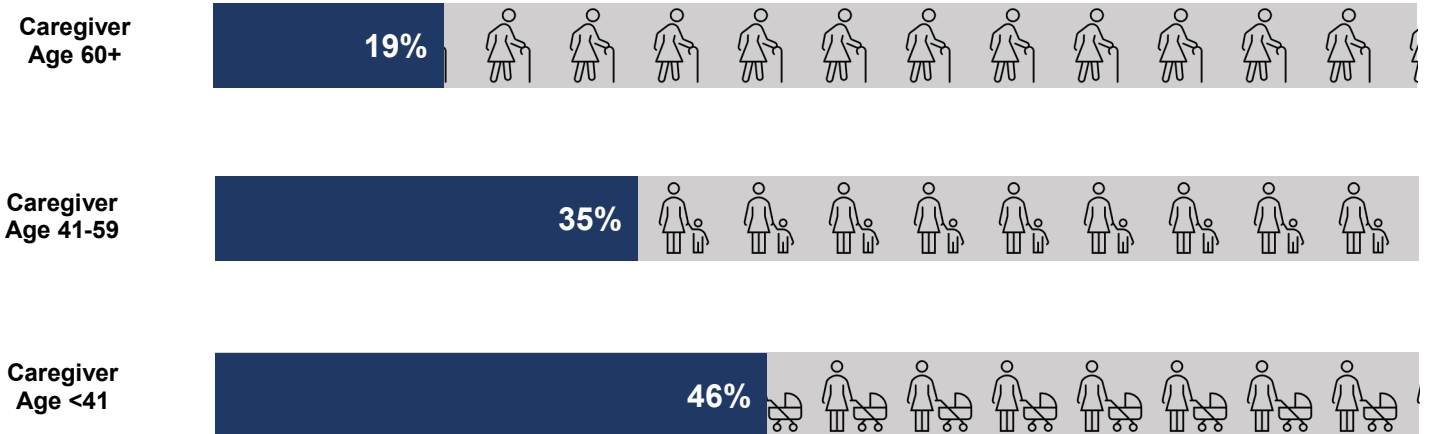

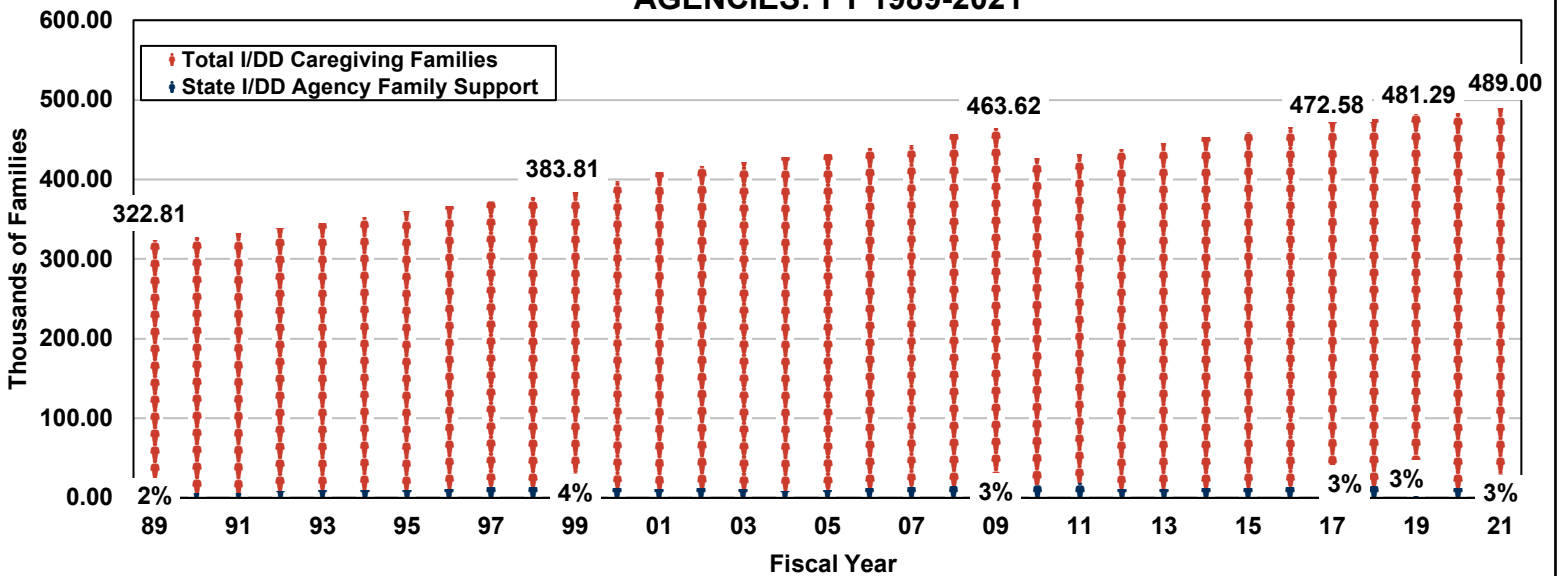
**ESTIMATED NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WITH I/DD BY LIVING ARRANGEMENT: FY 2021**
