

Question: In FY 2021, what were the top 5 states that show the highest amount of participants in Supported Living?







The State of the States in Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Project is a national longitudinal comparative study of financial and programmatic trends in spending on supports and services for people with intellectual/ developmental disabilities (IDD) in the United States. The project is funded by the U.S. Administration on Community Living as a Longitudinal Data Project of National Significance.

Please note that California, Wisconsin, Texas, and New York are highly populous areas.

Supported Living: Supports funded by the state IDD agency for adults in housing arrangements that guarantee: a) choice of where participants live and choice of housemates; b) control of the living arrangement by the individual, the individual's family or and organization not providing services to the individual with a disability; and c) supported living planning that recognizes the individual's changing needs for effective support in their living arrangement and daily life.
